All that certain lot or piece of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon erected, situate, lying and being in the borough of Juniata, now part of the City of Altoona, County of Blair and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fronting thirty (30) feet on the Northwestern side of Eighth Avenue between Second and Third Streets, and extending back one hundred fifteen (115) feet to an alley, and being Lot Number 18 in Block 7, in the plan of lots of Juniata Park, surveyed and plotted by C. M. Dechant, C.E., bounded on the Northwest by an alley; Northeast by an alley; Southeast by Eighth Avenue, and on the Southwest by Lot No. 19, in Block 7, in the plan of lots of Juniata Park. Having thereon erected a two-story brick-cased dwelling house No. 217 Eighth Avenue, according to present plan of numbering land and houses in said borough of Juniata, now part of Altoona City. Beginning at an iron pin set in the Westerly right-of-way line of Eighth Avenue, a variable width public right-of-way; said pin being at the Southeasterly corner of the lands now or formerly of Timothy W. and Brenda J. Plummer, as recorded in Deed Book 999, at Page 378; thence, departing said right-of-way line and running along and with the Northerly line of Plummer, North 47 degrees 05 minutes 23 seconds West, a distance of 115.00 feet to an iron pin set in the Easterly line of a fifteen foot (15') wide alley; thence, departing the lands of Plummer and running along and with said alley, the following two courses: North 42 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds East, a distance of 20.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence, North 87 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds East, a distance of 14.14 feet to a point in the Southerly line of a ten foot (10') wide alley; thence departing said fifteen foot (15') wide alley and running along and with said ten foot (10') wide alley, South 47 degrees 05 minutes 23 seconds East, a distance of 105.00 feet to an iron pin set in the aforementioned Eighth Avenue right-of-way line; thence, departing said alley and running along and with said right-of-way line, South 42 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds West, a distance of 30.00 feet to the point of beginning.
