Brown, said proceedings being of record in Blair County Will Book Volume 187, Page 366. The Last Will and Testament of Dorothy H. Brown devised and bequeathed the residue of her estate, which included the hereinabove described real property, to her daughter, Dorothy H. Brown, who joins in this deeds in her individual capacity.
